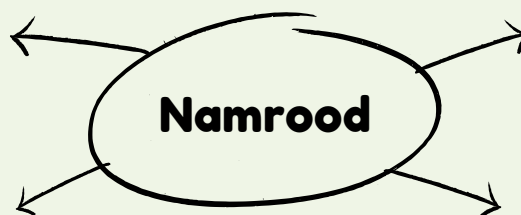

The story of Prophet Ibrahim (as) and Namrood is in Surah Baqarah (ayah 258)

Who is Allah?

As Muslims, these are the most important words we say and believe:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ
(La ilaha illallah)

It means that there is no god other than Allah. He is the One and Only true God. He created us, loves us and takes care of us. We must worship Him and obey all His rules.

We cannot see Allah but we can see His signs around us. We cannot imagine Allah because He is not like us or any other creation. He is perfect. He is the Most High.

Allah sees, hears and knows everything. And He has the power to do anything He wants!

Imagine you meet someone who doesn't know about Allah. What would you say to help them understand who Allah is?

The Sun's Journey

“Indeed, in the creation of the heavens and the earth and the alternation of the day and night there are signs for people of reason.” – Surah Ale Imran (3:190)

Allah has ordered the sun to rise from the East and set in the West. He created this perfect system and all the laws that we observe in the universe. Science is simply the study of these laws.

If Allah wants, He can change these laws too. He can do anything! One of the signs of Judgement Day will be that the sun will rise from the west instead of the east.



Did you know that the sun asks Allah for permission before rising everyday? (Sahih Bukhari:3199)

Qiblah Detectives

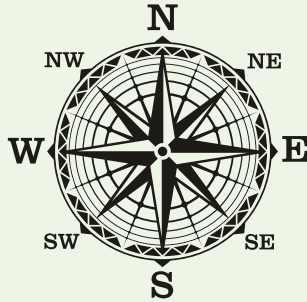
Imagine you're traveling with your family. You just watched the sun set and realize it's Maghrib time.

You need to pray, but there's no compass or phone to check the Qiblah, but you do know the direction of the Qiblah from your location (for e.g. in North America and Europe it is South East). What do you do?



You can use the sun to find the Qiblah!

Here's how:



1. Turn your face towards where the sun set
- that's WEST.

2. East is directly behind you (opposite of west).

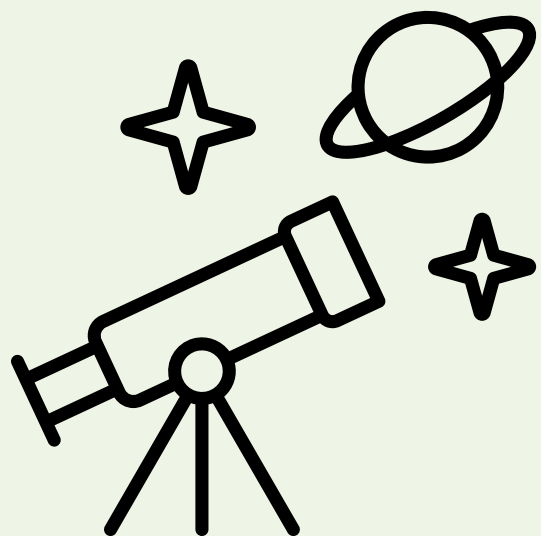
3. Based on this, we know North and South. Stretch out your arms. North is halfway between East and West at your right side, and South is halfway between East and West at your left side.

4. Now turn to the direction you know the Qiblah is located. For e.g. if you're in North America or Europe you should turn South-east (halfway between South and East), or if you're in Australia turn North-west (halfway between North and West).

Test Yourself!

Now go outside and try to find the Qiblah. Were you able to figure it out correctly?

Muslim scientists throughout history were experts in astronomy and navigation partly because they needed to determine the Qibla and prayer times accurately!
